

# What to Pack for Morocco



*This checklist is designed to be practical rather than exhaustive.  
Adjust it to suit your travel style and the season you are visiting.*

# Packing Checklist

## Clothing

- ☐ Long-sleeve tops
- ☐ Short-sleeve tops for warmer days
- ☐ Light jumper or cardigan for layering
- ☐ Lightweight jacket or packable puffer (especially for mornings and evenings)
- ☐ Jeans for cooler days and evenings
- ☐ Loose trousers for warmer days and comfort
- ☐ Optional: shorts (best in tourist-focused areas, and avoid very short shorts)
- ☐ Sleepwear
- ☐ Earplugs and an eye mask
- ☐ Packing cubes

## Shoes

- ☐ Comfortable trainers
- ☐ Sandals or other comfortable flats

## Accessories

- ☐ Scarf
- ☐ Sunglasses
- ☐ Hat
- ☐ Crossbody bag or small backpack with secure zips
- ☐ Phone lanyard / neck strap

## Toilets and hygiene essentials

- ☐ Hand sanitiser
- ☐ Tissues or toilet paper
- ☐ Small pack of wet wipes
- ☐ Lip balm
- ☐ Moisturiser or hand cream

## Tech and day-to-day logistics

- ☐ Universal travel adaptor (Type C and E are common)
- ☐ Portable power bank
- ☐ Charging cables
- ☐ Headphones

# Packing Checklist

## Tech and day-to-day logistics

- ☐ eSIM (ideally installed before arrival)

## Money and documents

- ☐ Moroccan dirhams
- ☐ Copies of passport and travel documents (digital and/or paper)
- ☐ Travel insurance details (saved on your phone and easy to access)

## Comfort and health

- ☐ Any regular medication (kept in original packaging)
- ☐ Basic pain relief
- ☐ Small first-aid kit (plasters, blister pads, antiseptic wipes)
- ☐ Rehydration sachets (optional)

## Laundry and clothing care

- ☐ Travel washing line
- ☐ Travel wash sheets or a small pack of laundry detergent
- ☐ A few pegs or clips (optional, but surprisingly useful)

## Practical extras

- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Refillable water bottle
- ☐ Lightweight rain jacket

## Luggage

- ☐ Small wheeled suitcase
- ☐ Day pack with secure zips
- ☐ Small crossbody bag
- ☐ Optional: foldable tote bag (useful for snacks, a scarf purchase, or extra bits during the day)

## What not to take

- ☐ Drones (not permitted and may be confiscated at the airport)
- ☐ Camouflage or military-style clothing
- ☐ Clothing with offensive slogans or images
